This funding will be used to

Support the following to be achieved:

- In each of the 5 domains of NAPLAN, 90% of students from Year 7 through to Year 9 achieve a similar or higher Relative Gain when compared to other State School cohorts
- In each of the 5 domains of NAPLAN, 90% of Year 7 and Year 9 students achieve a positive Raw Gain
- Increase our National Minimum Standards benchmarks to 95% or above in all 5 domains of NAPLAN
- Improve the percentage of Year 12 Overall Position (OP) eligible students in the 1–5 range to 15% or above
- 10% of students graduate with either a completed school-based traineeship or having commenced a school-based apprenticeship
- Continue to build a professional learning culture that focusses on continuously developing staff capability and quality of teaching to impact on the learning experience and outcomes for our students
- Reduce school disciplinary absences by 5%

Our initiatives include

- Continue implementation of our Reading and Writing Framework to ensure reading comprehension and targeted writing strategies are integrated into all subject areas
- Commence implementation of the Gradual Release of Responsibility as our new school-wide pedagogical framework
- Introduction of Attitude to Learning Framework as a school-wide strategy to strengthen student engagement and connectedness to our school
- Continue to enhance learning spaces for teachers and school leaders to create new, engaging pedagogy modes that develop students 21st Century learning skills

Continue implementation of the Reading and Writing Framework with precision to specifically target improvements in reading comprehension and sustained writing skills. This will include curriculum planning release time and targeted professional development.	\$50,000

Implementation of specific intervention strategies for identified target student groups e.g. Academic Excellence students, at-risk students, school-based traineeships and apprenticeships	\$225,224
Implementation of a range of Positive Education strategies to support student engagement. This will include targeted planning time and development of a whole school implementation plan	\$125,000
Purchasing resources, online licences, digital devices and learning space enhancements	\$48,000
